



## Fonds 10

Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry Association fonds. – 1927-2019. – 4.9 m of textual records and other material.

During the First World War veterans of Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry (PPCLI) in Ottawa began to gather informally. The Patricia Club of Ottawa was formed 27 December 1917. Other Patricia Clubs were later formed in some of the larger Canadian cities. These clubs provided personal assistance to veterans and their families as well as other public services. Following the Second World War, on 18 May 1946, Hamilton Gault organized the first meeting of the PPCLI Association. On 13 September 1953, the PPCLI Association was incorporated. It was structured with autonomous Branches in Canadian cities or regions, and one Branch in the United Kingdom. From 1953 to 1994, the Association ran the PPCLI Regimental Museum and Archives. In 1964 the Association established the Hamilton Gault Memorial Fund for charitable purposes. From about 1982 to about 1994 the Regimental Adjutant was also Secretary-Treasurer of the Association. As of 2017, the Association consisted of 10 Branches across Canada.

The fonds includes Constitution and Bylaws, minutes of general and Executive meetings, executive correspondence and reports, newsletters, files on Branches, nominal rolls and membership directories, records of the Calgary Branch, financial records, records of commemorative events, records of the Regimental Museum, records of the Memorial Hall of Honour Project, records of the Hamilton Gault Memorial Fund, and photographs.

The fonds was transferred from the PPCLI Association, 1946-2019.

The fonds was formerly Series 252 of Collection 1, the PPCLI General Collection, and the inventory is structured with the old box-and-file numbering system integrated with a new consecutive numbering system.

Access to files in the Hamilton Gault Memorial Fund series pertaining to student bursaries is restricted.

Series 2.2	General Committee/Executive Council meetings. -1964-2019. – 31 cm of textual records. – The 1953 Constitution provided for governance by a General Committee, consisting of the Colonel of the Regiment, commanding officers of the Regiment, table officers, and presidents of the Branches of the Association. There was provision for appointment of an Executive Committee to supervise the routine work of the Association. The General Committee usually met in conjunction with the Annual General Meeting, but in the 1960s it began to hold separate meetings. In the 1985 constitution the General Committee was replaced by the Executive Council, later known simply as the Council. The 2005 constitution created the Executive Committee, sometimes known as the Executive Council. By 2014 the main executive body was known as the Board of Directors, and by 2016 it was known as the Council of Presidents. – Arranged chronologically. From about 1982 to about 1994, the Secretary-Treasurer of the Association was also the Regimental Adjutant. The Float Files were retained at Regimental Headquarters for the information of officers of the Regiment, and include minutes and constitutional documents. – Arranged in approximate chronological order.	13

Series 4	<p>Association newsletters. – 1946-2019. – 35 cm of textual records. – This series consists of the <i>Regimental Newsletter</i>, the <i>Association Newsletter</i>, correspondence regarding its production and publication, and other publications of the PPCLI Association. The <i>Regimental Newsletter</i> was initially a publication of the Regiment from 1946 to 1953. The <i>Association News Bulletin</i> was published by the PPCLI Association, 1958-1963. The Patricia Club, a branch of the Association consisting of veterans of the Great War, published its own newsletter, 1963-1975. The <i>Regimental Newsletter</i> was revived as a joint publication of the Regiment and the Association from 1969 to 1982. Its title was changed to simply <i>Newsletter</i> in 1982 and in 1984 it began to be published solely by the Association. It was renamed <i>Association Newsletter</i> beginning in 1993.
